

Overseas Student Health Cover Policy

PURPOSE:

1. All International Students are required by law to have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) prior to VISA approval. Students are to obtain this cover prior to entry into Australia and are to be covered from the day they arrive until the end of the issued VISA.

SCOPE:

2. This policy applies to all Students who are making application to, or commencing study with Superior Training Centre.

PROCEDURE:

- 3. As a condition of the student VISA, the Australian Government requires the student to have Overseas Student Health Cover.
 - a) Superior Training Centre can provide OSHC through one of the following:
 - i. Australian Health Management
 - ii. Allianz Global Assistance (Lysaght Peoplecare)
 - iii. BUPA Australia
 - iv. Medibank Private
 - v. nib
 - and will provide the associated fees and charges on the Letter of Offer, or
 - b) The student is free to arrange OSHC themselves
 - i. Students will not be able to obtain a valid Student VISA, if they do not have proof of OSHC

SUPERIOR TRAINING CENTRE ARRANGED

- 4. As part of the Application for Enrolment students are required to indicate whether they require Superior Training Centre to provide OSHC.
- 5. If Superior Training Centre is to arrange cover, the associated fees will be listed on the Letter of Offer and must be paid at the time of acceptance.
 - a. Failure to pay the required fee may affect the Confirmation of Enrolment provided by Superior Training Centre as well as your Student VISA application

STUDENT ARRANGED

6. As part of the Application for Enrolment students are required to indicate whether they will arrange their own OSHC cover.



- 7. If the student is to arrange cover, they are required to provide Superior Training Centre with all details to validate a Confirmation of Enrolment.
 - a. Failure to obtain OSHC may result in the Student VISA application being denied
